
HISTORY

Youth Crossroads began as the Youth in Crisis Project in 1971 to provide crisis intervention for homeless youth, drug abuse counseling and support services for underserved teens in the western suburbs. The project proved successful enough that in 1974, organizers incorporated as an independent non-profit known as West Suburban Youth Outreach, Inc, which was later changed to Youth In Crisis. In 1978, the agency moved into its own facility and continued to evolve and expand services over the next three decades.

In 2007, the agency changed its name to Youth Crossroads, Inc. to better reflect the evolution of services towards prevention of problems rather than only reacting to problems that had reached crisis stage. The Youth Leadership Program was started in 2008, and the Community School Initiative and After-School Programs for middle school students was launched in 2009. In 2022, the Workforce Development Program was launched and a satellite location opened in Cicero. Since its creation, Youth Crossroads has served tens of thousands of youth and their families from Berwyn, Cicero, Stickney, and neighboring towns. We've partnered with more than 100 community organizations to create a network of referral sources to address the complex issues confronting youth and families. Today Youth Crossroads offers a continuum of services to help local youth heal, grow, lead, and thrive. We also serve as the fiscal agent for the Cicero Community Collaborative and All Our Kids Network Cicero.

Robert "Bob" Lovero has has lived in Berwyn for over sixty years with his family and made public service an integral part of his life.

Bob graduated from St. Mary of Celle school and Fenwick High School before earning a Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice at Loyola University and graduating from Northern Illinois University College of Law. After passing the bar in 1981, Bob served as Assistant City Attorney and City Prosecutor to the City of Berwyn. He also practiced at a few Chicago law firms before opening the Berwyn practice that continues today. He served the City of Berwyn as 7th Ward Alderman from 2000 to 2009, when he was elected Mayor.

Since then, Bob has played a leading role in a business renaissance that has revitalized the Depot District, Route 66 along Ogden Avenue, Cermak Road and Roosevelt Road —the "Veltway". In collaboration with the Berwyn Development Corporation, Bob has presided over upgrading streetscapes throughout the Berwyn community. This beautification of Berwyn, along with his actively seeking out and welcoming new business, has brought great companies to Berwyn.

For over 14 years, Bob has provided Thanksgiving dinner to feed underprivileged Berwyn residents and has provided several hundred food baskets to families each Christmas season.

Bob has consistently been active in several community and professional organizations: West Central Municipal Conference Executive Board, 2010 to 2015, and served as President from 2013 to 2014; American Bar Association; Chicago Bar Association; West Suburban Bar Association; Justinian Society of Lawyers; Illinois State Bar Association; The Italian-American Civic Organization of Berwyn, President 1996–1998, 2010 Man of the Year; Berwyn Democratic Organization; Township Democratic Committeeman 2005 – present; Berwyn Township 708 Mental Health Board, 1987–1990; Berwyn Development Corporation; Blue Ribbon Historical Committee; Local Law Enforcement Advisory Board; co-chairman of the Berwyn Holiday Fund.

Bob continues to evolve as a city leader, embracing youth leadership initiatives and community coalitions. With more than 25 years of service, Bob continues to energetically serve the residents of Berwyn by example and through intelligent leadership.




